Please read the following directions prior to filling out the application. Once you complete the application, print it and email it with the rest of your materials.

Who is Eligible:

- Only students who currently live in the 46th District of Maryland are eligible to apply
- Only students who plan to attend a Maryland college or university or a private career school are eligible. Private career schools must have the Maryland Higher Education Commission's approval to operate and must be accredited by a national accrediting association approved by the U.S. Department of Education. You may also attend a nursing school if the Commission approves the curriculum.
- Part-time or full-time students are eligible.
- You may use this scholarship at an out-of-state school if your major is not available at a Maryland schools. The Office of Student Financial Assistance must verify your major is unique. You can call Sue Koch at 410-260-4548 for more information.

Attach your letter of recommendation, short answer responses, a copy of your FAFSA Student Aid Report and a sealed copy of your official transcript.
